Dear Member,

The Island Water Association, Inc. (IWA) is planning improvements in the Brightwater Subdivision this year. The improvements are part of an ongoing program to upgrade older water pipes that are prone to leakage or failure. These leaks or failures can result in outages and significant damage to surrounding areas.

The replacement is expected to begin this summer and will continue for several months thereafter. The streets affected during this project are: St Kilda Road, Tiree Circle, and Barra Circle. The funding for the project is entirely from the IWA capital budget for 2019 and adds no additional cost to our members.

As is the case in any construction project, the excavated areas will be restored as close as reasonably possible to the preexisting condition. There may be areas that remain disturbed for the duration of the project. These areas often require multiple excavations and are typically necessary to satisfy regulatory requirements.

Vegetation and private irrigation systems within the right-of-way are often a source of frustration during these projects for both the homeowner and the contractor. The contractors will do their best to avoid/minimize damage. However, it may be necessary to impact these items to allow the installation.

During the project it's likely there will be unexpected interruptions to water, other utilities, and traffic flow. IWA will do its best to minimize these interruptions.
